This magnificent property forms part of the former Willesley House, built in the early 18th century. Between 1864 – 1870, the painter J.C. Horsley commisioned architect Richard Norman Shaw to convert and extend this historic attached property which boasts fine examples of the influences that defined the architect. Features abound from the gable detailing, tilehangings, tall chimney stacks, incised ceiling patterns and a marvelous peacock with eyes and tail feathers made of green bottle glass bases under the gable end with the inscription "except the Lord build the house, they labour in vain that build it", to name but a few.


The rooms are generously proportioned, with a magnificent oak panelled drawing room with original leaded windows and a substantial inlenook fireplace which overlooks the pretty lawned garden to the rear.








DIRECTIONS
